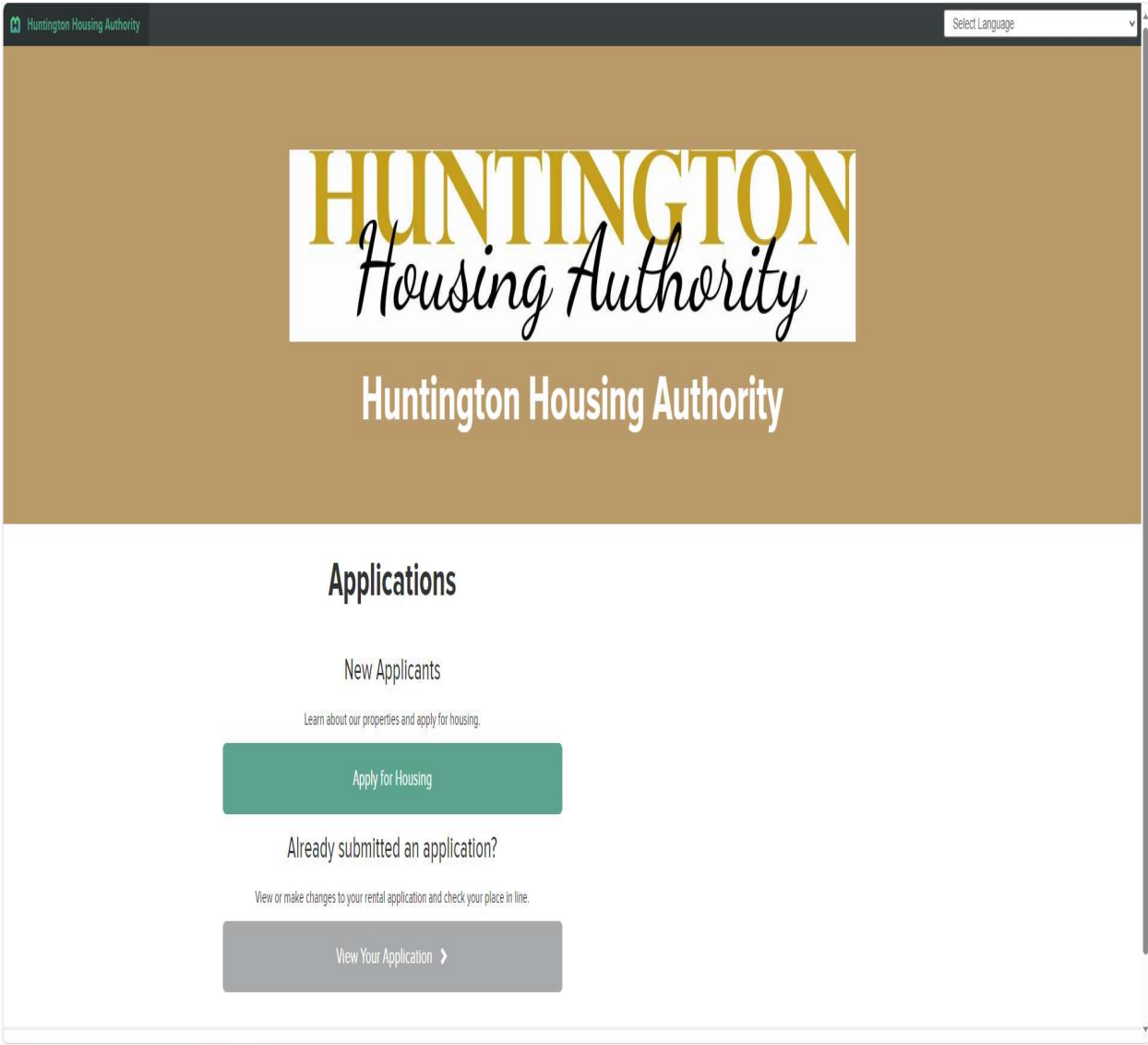

HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER is rental assistance for persons renting homes on the private market. Resident chooses an apartment, house, mobile home, or duplex. Once the home passes a quality inspection & the rent is determined to be reasonable, the resident pays rent, based on their income, to the landlord, & Town of Huntington Housing Authority assists with the remainder. Utilities vary according to the unit selected.
